# Maury Express Service Update

As a provider of public transportation, our primary concern is the health of our operators, staff, passengers and neighborhoods we serve. After careful consideration The Maury Express transportation system will shut down beginning Wednesday, 4/8/2020. It is expected that the shutdown will last the duration of the Executive Order, currently with an end date of June 10th, 2020.

Our operators will continue disinfecting and sanitizing the vehicles during their morning vehicle inspection, as well as spot cleaning throughout the day as time permits. We ask that passengers continue to help practice social distancing by spacing out on the vehicle.

Any changes to service level will be distributed by normal means (Facebook, TV, Radio, etc.). We will continue to closely monitor the ongoing developments and safety information related to the coronavirus (COVID-19).
